Dear CDCTA Members:

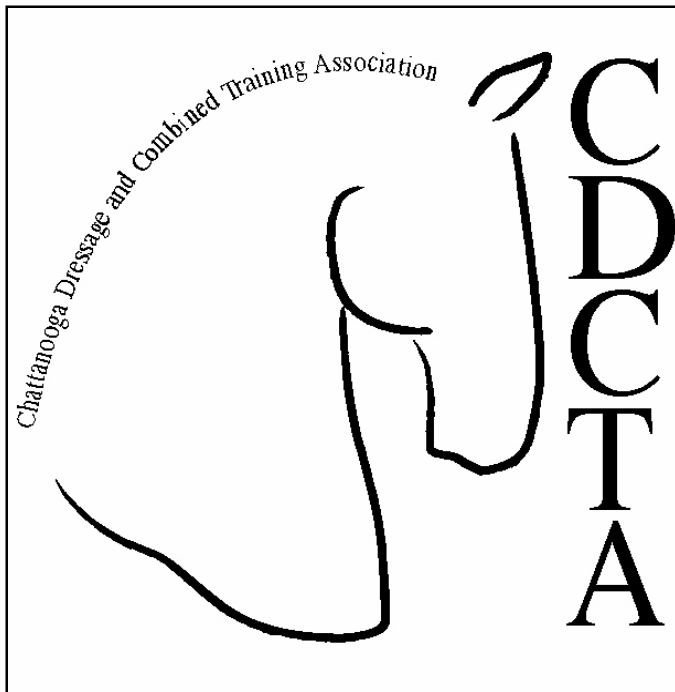
